

Oklahoma High School Rodeo Association

Welcome to the 2018-19 season of the Oklahoma High School Rodeo Association. Enclosed you will find several items to look over and a few to fill out. Completed forms are due back in the secretary's hands by Saturday, August 11th, which is one week prior to the first rodeo, August 18-19 at El Reno. **All entries are due no later than one week or the Saturday before each rodeo you are entering including the first rodeo at El Reno.**

Below is a list of the items you must return:

- 1) Rodeo Entry Form (with check attached)**
- 2) Oklahoma High School Membership form**
- 3) National High School Membership form (with \$149 included)**
- 4) Minor's release (EVERYONE must fill one out)**
- 5) W-9 Form (EVERYONE must turn this in)**
- 6) A copy of contestant's enrollment for HS on School letterhead**
- 7) Membership Survey**
- 8) (YOU MUST TURN ALL THIS PAPERWORK IN BEFORE YOU CAN RODEO!!)**

Unless otherwise noted, rodeo performances will start at 12 pm on Saturdays and 10 am on Sundays. There will be a few rodeos that will have different start times so PLEASE WATCH the website/FB and for announcements at the rodeos for possible different start times. Church is at 8:30 am on Sundays unless otherwise announced at the rodeos prior to Sunday.

During your High School career we **DO NOT** mail out any packets, entry forms, or information. You are responsible for checking the OHSRA website and Facebook and then printing your forms from the website yourself. Information will ALWAYS be posted at the rodeo on my bulletin boards, announced at rodeos, put on the website and/or FB page. If you do not have internet you can ALWAYS pre-enter for ALL rodeos rodeo in the office. I will have entry forms at the rodeo office to fill out. Place it along with your check in the lock box provided.

****Cutting and/or Reined Cow horse events** (Please be aware of the following.)
****Cuttings:** We will have 18 cuttings just as we do the rodeos so it can be counted in the ALL Around for points. The Cutting events may or may not be held along with our rodeos depending on the location and cattle available. Please watch the website, FB, and information boards located at the rodeos for this information. YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE for knowing when and where these will be held and the deadline to be entered by to compete at that cutting.
****Reined cow horse:** RCH will also be run the same way, but we WILL NOT have 18 of these and the points WILL NOT be counted in the All-Around, until the State Finals. Again YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE for knowing when and where these will be held and when you have to be entered by to attend that RCH event. These will be posted on and at the various locations as stated above for the cutting events.

--**1st & 2nd rodeo / El Reno Aug. 18-19.** (NO STALLS or RV HOOKUPS at this rodeo)

Contestants must check in from 9:00am-11:00 am Saturday morning.

**You will receive your back numbers and membership packets.

****There will have a MANDATORY contestant meeting at 12:00 noon Saturday. EVERYONE MUST ATTEND THIS MEETING.**

**Our first rodeo at El Reno will start 2:00 pm Saturday and 10:00 am Sunday.

**We will hand out the fundraiser calendars.

**Each contestant will be responsible for selling 20 of these calendars @ \$20 each.

**Calendar money has to be turned in by Sunday November 4th at Lazy E Arena rodeo. If these are NOT turned in on this date you will lose your points you have accumulated up to this point.

--**3rd & 4th rodeo / Shawnee @ Shawnee Expo Center Sept. 8th-9th (w/OKJHSRA)**

****There are Stalls and RV Hook ups at this rodeo. (STALLS ARE MANDATORY)**

**Put these on your entry form when entering.

**Stalls - \$20 PER NIGHT or \$35 WEEKEND

**RV - \$25 PER NIGHT

**You will pick up stall and RV tags at the rodeo office Saturday morning. You MUST have your stall tags on your stalls!!!!)

**Start Times Saturday 12:00pm and Sunday 10:00am

--**5th & 6th rodeo / Woodward Sept. 29-30. (w/OKJHSRA)**

** Start time Saturday at 12:00 and Sunday at 10:00am

**Stalls are \$20/weekend.

**Hookups are \$20/weekend.

**Please stalls and hookups on your entry form.

**PLEASE be considerate when parking there will be a lot of trailers since it is a joint rodeo with the OkJHSRA.

**We will rodeo in the big arena.

--**7th & 8th rodeo / Stigler Oct. 13-14th.**

(NO STALLS OR HOOKUPS AT THIS RODEO)

****Start Times for this rodeo are Saturday 12:00pm & Sunday 10:00am**

--**9th & 10th rodeo / FALL BASH Lazy E Arena November 2-4.**

****We will rodeo with OKJHSRA, THSRA,& THJHSRA**

****Rodeo start time Sat. 10:00 am / Sun. 10:00 am**

****STALLS ARE MANDATORY at this rodeo. (NO TIE-OUTS)**

**Stall and RV will be purchased through the Lazy E office.

**DO NOT INCLUDE STALLS OR RV FEES ON YOUR ENTRY FORM

****All Calendar Money is due at Lazy E Arena Rodeo, November 4th.**

You WILL lose your points if not turned in at this rodeo!!

***All entry forms can be turned in to rodeo office **prior** to the next rodeo. The checks will not be deposited until the Monday following the rodeo we are at unless otherwise stated.

*****A late fee of \$25.00 if you enter from Sunday am until Tuesday at 9:00pm.**

*****A late fee of \$75.00 after Tuesday at 9:00pm prior to the rodeo.**

(This MUST be paid BEFORE you make your run at the rodeo)

****No Exceptions!!!!**

***If a contestant enters late after the draw is posted he or she will automatically be placed at the top, and will be given the worst position (i.e. at the top for roping or the bottom for barrels and poles), plus the \$75 late fee added.

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“IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR THIS 2018-19 RODEO SEASON”

PLEASE READ YOUR STATE RULEBOOK SO YOU WILL KNOW THE RULES WE FOLLOW THROUGHOUT THE YEAR!!!

*** **SECRETARY FEE** -- On all rodeo entry forms you will have a \$8 secretary fee per day or per round at Cutting/RCH events that you are required to pay.

*** **GATE FEE** -- We will still be having our gate fee on the entry forms. It will be added onto each rodeo entry \$10.00 per day

*****IMPORTANT Team Ropers NOTICE....**

****Team ropers will get a second run beginning this year. Your 2nd run will be like a USTRC run and MUST be a #12 point run using the USTRC numbering rules.**

If you do not have a USTRC card with a number the directors will number you.

****If you DO NOT have a partner I will have a list of Team Roper names that are willing to be put in a draw pot. If you do not have a partner, you WILL NOT be able to pick who you rope with - your partner will be drawn (by the office) from the pot.**

You will only be allowed to draw 4 times for the year (NOT 4 WEEKENDS), After that you MUST have a partner if you wish to continue in the team roping event. After you have drawn your 4 times, finding a team roping partner is your responsibility, not the secretaries. When you enter YOU MUST HAVE SOMEONE TO ENTER WITH, DO NOT LEAVE THE PARTNERS LINE BLANK.

- Team Ropers – If you would like your name in the pot and are willing to rope with someone that does not have a partner please turn your name in to me ASAP. You **WILL NOT** be charged for being a helper for that person UNLESS you place and win money at which time your entry fees will then be deducted from your winnings. The draw partner **WILL NOT** receive points for his draw run - only money if you place.

***** Mothers Club Information**

Examples: Cowboy Prom at State Finals, T-shirts sales, and working the concession stands at the rodeos.
