

Oklahoma High School Rodeo Association

Welcome to the 2017-18 season of the Oklahoma High School Rodeo

Association. Enclosed you will find several items to look over and a few to fill out. Completed forms are due back in the secretary's hands by Saturday, August 12th, which is one week prior to the first rodeo, August 19-20 at El Reno. **All entries are due no later than one week or the Saturday before each rodeo you are entering including the first rodeo at El Reno.**

Below is a list of the items you must return:

- 1) Rodeo Entry Form (with check attached)**
- 2) Oklahoma High School Membership form**
- 3) National High School Membership form (with \$149 included)**
- 4) Minor's release (EVERYONE must fill one out)**
- 5) W-9 Form (EVERYONE must turn this in)**
- 6) A copy of contestant's enrollment for HS on School letterhead**
- 7) Membership Survey (YOU MUST TURN THIS IN BEFORE YOU CAN RODEO!!)**

Unless otherwise noted, rodeo performances will start at 12 pm on Saturdays and 10 am on Sundays. There will be a few rodeos that will have different start times so PLEASE WATCH the website/FB and for announcements at the rodeos for possible different start times. Church is usually at 8:30 am on Sundays unless otherwise announced at the rodeos prior to Sunday.

During your High School career, we **DO NOT** mail out any packets, entry forms, or information, unless it is an emergency. You are responsible for checking the OHSRA website and Facebook page and then printing your forms from the website yourself. Information will ALWAYS be posted at the rodeo on my bulletin boards, announced at rodeos, put on the website and/or FB page. It is **your** responsibility to be aware of new info from those places on your own. If you do not have internet you can ALWAYS pre-enter for ALL rodeos rodeo in the office 1 week prior to the rodeo you are entering. I will have entry forms at the rodeo office to fill out. Place it along with your check in the lock box provided.

****Cutting and/or Reined Cow horse events** (Please be aware of the following.)
****Cuttings:** We will have 20 cuttings just as we do the rodeos so it can be counted in the ALL Around for points. The Cutting events may or may not be held along with our rodeos depending on the location and cattle available. Please watch the website, FB, and information boards located at the rodeos for this information. YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE for knowing when and where these will be held and the deadline to be entered by to compete at that cutting.

****Reined cow horse:** RCH will also be run the same way, but we WILL NOT have 20 of these and the points WILL NOT be counted in the All-Around, until the State Finals. Again YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE for knowing when and where these will be

held and when you have to be entered by to attend that RCH event. These will be posted on and at the various locations as stated above for the cutting events.

--**1st rodeo / El Reno Aug. 19-20.**

2 Rds. Cutting- 8:00 AM @ Wade Smith's in Calumet (PLEASE WATCH WEBSITE AND FB FOR MORE INFO ON RODEO AND CUTTING CHECK IN TIMES)

Contestants must check in from 9:00-11:00 am at El Reno rodeo. You will receive your back numbers and all other contestant information. **We will have a MANDATORY contestant meeting at 12:00 noon. EVERYONE MUST ATTEND this meeting.**

**Our first rodeo at El Reno will start 2:00 pm Saturday and 10:00 am Sunday.

**At Shawnee rodeo, we will hand out the fundraiser calendars. Each contestant will be responsible for selling 20 calendars @ \$20 each. Calendar money MUST be turned in before Sunday November 5th at Lazy E Arena Rodeo.

--**2nd rodeo / Shawnee Sept. 9-10. (w/OKJHSRA)**

2 Rds. of Reined Cow Horse Saturday Sept. 9 @ 9:00 am.

****Stalls** are **MANDATORY** at this rodeo if you are keeping your horses on the grounds (no tie outs). The stalls will be \$25.00 for the weekend. \$15.00 for 1 night. Include the stall money on your entry form for this rodeo.

****Hook ups** are also available at this rodeo but The Shawnee Expo will oversee collecting the fees for this. The fee for electric will be \$20 for the weekend.

*****This rodeo will start at 12:00 pm Saturday and 10:00 am Sunday. Order of events for this rodeo will be adjusted and WILL BE posted in advance.***

--**3rd rodeo / Beaver Sept. 16-17th.**

**2 Rds. of Cutting Sept. 16- 8:00 am (location TBA)
(NO STALLS OR HOOKUPS AT THIS RODEO)**

--**4th rodeo / Woodward Sept. 30-Oct. 1. (w/OKJHSRA)**

2 Rds. Cutting Sept. 30- 8:00 am (location TBA)

**The Stalls are \$20/weekend.

**Hookups are \$20/weekend.

You must sign up and pay for stalls and hookups on your entry form.

--**5th rodeo / Stigler Oct. 14-15.**

(NO STALLS OR HOOKUPS AT THIS RODEO)

2 Rds. Cutting Sat. Oct. 14- 8:00 am at Stigler RUC arena

--**6th rodeo / FALL BASH Lazy E Arena November 3-5th. (w/OKJHSRA)**

2 Rds. Cutting on Friday Nov. 3 (6:00pm Cutting start time)

****Rodeo start time Sat. 10:00 am / Sun. 10:00 am**

Stalls are **MANDATORY** at this rodeo. (NO TIE-OUTS)

**Stall and RV will be purchased through the Lazy E office.

--**September 23** – Woodward- **Cutting- 8:00am** (2 rds. At RUC arena)

Woodward- **RCH will be per SRCHA schedule**

--**October 28 / Cutting Event- 8:00 am** 2 rounds @ Wade Smiths in Calumet Ok

All Calendar Money is due at Lazy E Arena Rodeo, November 5.

If you will not be at this rodeo then you will need to make arrangements to get your money to the secretaries BEFORE this rodeo.

(IF YOU DO NOT TURN YOUR CALENDAR MONEY IN AT THIS RODEO YOU WILL LOSE YOUR POINTS YOU HAVE ACCUMULATED UP TO THIS POINT!!!!)

***All entry forms can be turned in to rodeo office **prior** to the next rodeo. The checks will not be deposited until the Monday following the rodeo we are at unless otherwise stated.

*****A late fee of \$25.00 if you enter from Sunday am until Tuesday at 9:00pm.**

*****A late fee of \$75.00 after Tuesday at 9:00pm prior to the rodeo.**

(This MUST be paid BEFORE you make your run at the rodeo)

****No Exceptions!!!!**

***If a contestant enters late after the draw is posted he or she will automatically be given worst position (i.e. at the top for roping or the bottom for barrels and poles), plus the \$75 late fee added.

“IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR THIS 2017-18 RODEO SEASON”

PLEASE READ YOUR STATE RULEBOOK SO YOU WILL KNOW THE RULES WE FOLLOW THROUGHOUT THE YEAR!!!

***** SECRETARY FEE -- On all rodeo entry forms you will have a \$6 secretary fee per day or per round (Cutting/RCH events) that you are required to pay.**

***** GATE FEE -- We will still be having our gate fee on the entry forms.**

It will be added onto each rodeo entry. \$5.00 per day / \$10 for the weekend whether you have 1 or 10 people with you. It will be just a flat fee for everyone. **Except for certain events as Border Bash and State Finals.**

***** Team Ropers NOTICE....**

If you DO NOT have a partner I will have a list of Team Roper names that are willing to be put in a draw pot. If you do not have a partner, you WILL NOT be able to pick who you rope with - your partner will be drawn (by the office) from the pot.

You will only be allowed to draw 4 times for the year (NOT 4 WEEKENDS), After that you MUST have a permanent partner if you wish to continue in the team roping event. After you have drawn your 4 times, finding a team roping partner is your responsibility, not the secretaries. When you enter YOU MUST HAVE SOMEONE TO ENTER WITH, DO NOT LEAVE THE PARTNERS LINE BLANK.

- Team Ropers – If you would like your name in the pot and are willing to rope with someone that does not have a partner please turn your name in to me ASAP. You **WILL NOT** be charged for being a helper for that person UNLESS you place and win money at which time your entry fees will then be deducted from your winnings. The draw partner **WILL NOT** receive points for his draw run - only money if you place.

***** Mothers Club Information**

*******The “Mother’s Club” is a great group of parents that put-on events and schedule fundraisers throughout the rodeo season. Examples: Cowboy Prom at State Finals, T-shirts sales, and working other fundraisers such as the “pie auction” at the Border Bash. All volunteering is greatly appreciated!
